TIME & LOCATION

Saturday, April 21, 2018 at 9:30am in the
Brukner Nature Center parking lot.

Directions: Take exit #73 off I-75, go west on St.
Rt. 55, 2.4 miles, turn right onto Horseshoe Bend
Road, 2.1 miles to BNC entrance on the right.
Parking available in nature center lot. **No one
can leave the parking lot until the race is
finished.** Please carpool!



ENTRY FEE

Registration fee is **\$25 per person (just
\$20 for BNC Members!)** with a recycled
short-sleeved T-shirt (**registrations after
April 1 will not be guaranteed a t-shirt.**)
If you choose the 'no T-shirt' option, simply
deduct \$5 from your registration fee.

**All registrations must be postmarked
by Thursday, April 12 or dropped off
by 5pm on Sunday, April 15.** Be sure to
send your registration in before the deadline
so you don't miss out on all the fun! **This
is a pre-registration-only event; our
maximum number of participants is
250 so sign up early! No walk-ins.**

CHECK-IN. Beat the rush on race day
morning and stop by Friday, April 20 from
5:00-6:30pm for packet pick-up! Check-in on
race day will be held from **8:00 - 9:15am**
only. There will be no registration the day
of the race. **Entrance closes at 9:15am
and no one can enter after that time!**

COURSE starts and finishes at the parking lot
and winds through the woods along the trails.
Steep hills and rough terrain involved but you
can handle it! And the wildflowers are amazing!!

STATIONS & FACILITIES - One water station
is located on the course. Split times will be given
at each mile. Restrooms are available inside the
nature center. Yummy refreshments will be at
the finish line. **Race will be run rain or shine.**

AWARDS - Awards will be given after the race to
the top three males and females overall, and the
top two males and females in each age category!

DOOR PRIZES - All participants are eligible for
door prizes and must be present to win. Prizes
will be given away before awards. **(Don't miss
these - they're wild! This year we have LOTS
of cool giveaways!)**

MORE COOL INFO - All proceeds from this
event help support our wildlife programs! Bring
a friend! Walkers are welcome! No pets allowed
on Brukner Nature Center grounds - they scare
our Wildlife Ambassadors.

WILDLIFE - BNC has over 50 live animals on
display. Come meet some of our wildlife ambas-
sadors after the race. BNC also operates a wildlife
rehabilitation unit accepting native Ohio wildlife
for care and rehabilitation. Last year we accepted
over 1,500 wildlife rehab patients!

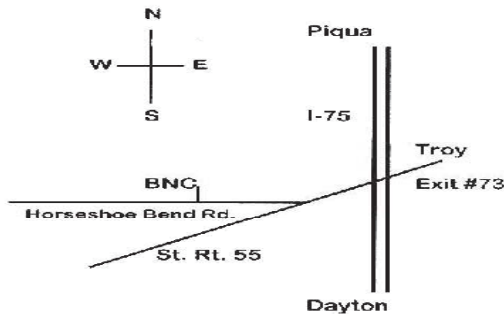
