

Did you know that ...

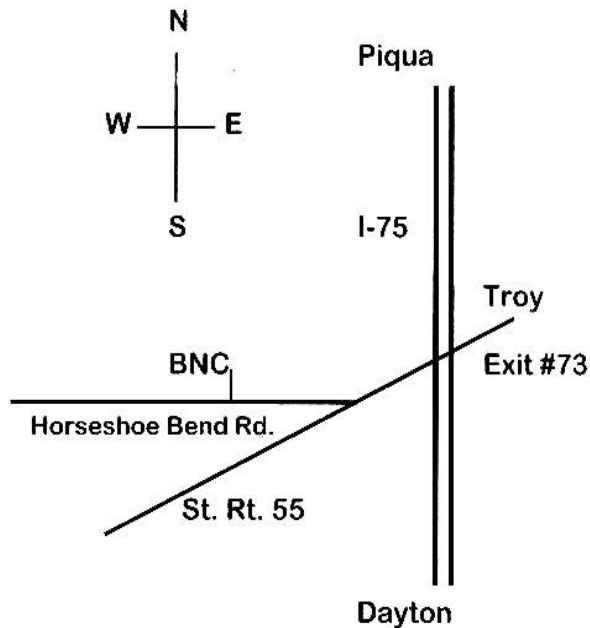
In just **one year** our Wildlife Ambassadors will consume:

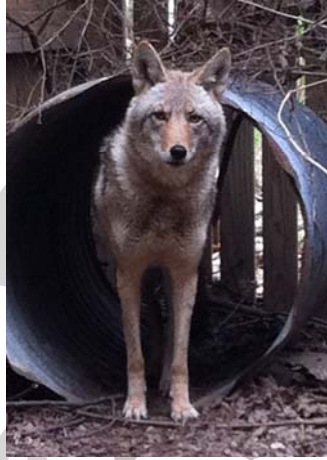
