BNC has a variety of habitats and wildlife in part because we’re next to the Scenic Stillwater River. Known for its slow moving, clean and clear water, the Stillwater River is home to many pollution intolerant fish and macroinvertebrate species. Join us as we explore the river while tubing from our main building to our River’s Edge property - located on Calumet Road. Along the way we will use nets to catch and evaluate aquatic creatures, use snorkeling masks to observe the underwater habitat, watch for mammals and birds along the shorelines, and more! Maximum 10 kids.

REGISTRATION GUIDELINES:

- **Payment for Programs:** Payment is due at the time of registration. Cash or check only.
- **Medical Consent Forms:** Must be completed prior to the start of camp. Forms can be found online at bruknernaturecenter.com/assets/bnc_medical-consent-form.pdf.
- **Withdrawal Policy:** Reimbursement of payment registration is not available for any program cancellation within two (2) weeks of the start of a program. Cancellation occurring more than 2 weeks prior to the start of a program, will receive a 50% refund.
- **Participant Sign-in/out:** Parents will be required to sign-in their child each day and children will only be released from BNC when their parent/adult arrives to pick them up.
- **Dismissal of Participant:** BNC staff reserve the right to dismiss a child from a program if his/her behavior is negatively affecting the group. A refund is not issued if a participant is dismissed from a program.
